'Cleanliness is next to Godliness.'

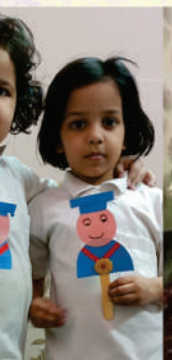
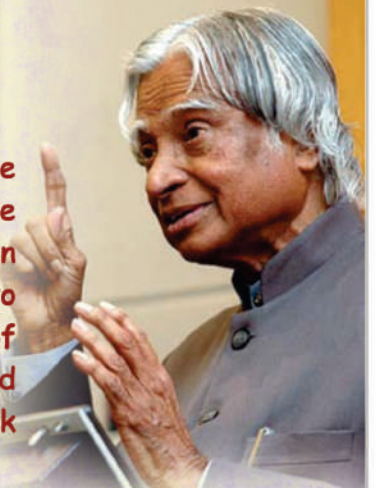

Eat Healthy, Stay Healthy WORLD FOOD DAY

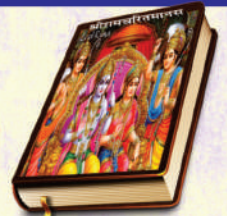

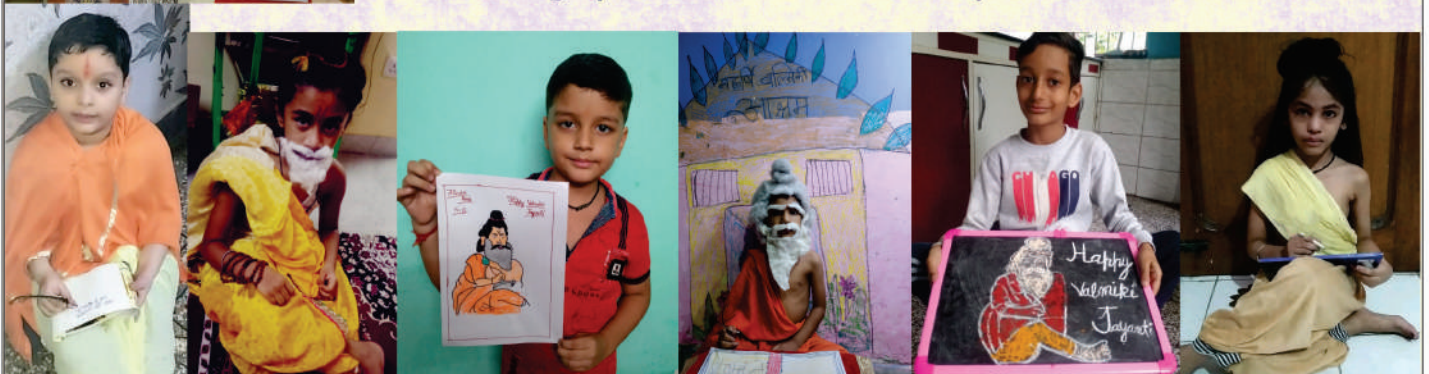


Valmiki Jayanti

CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATION

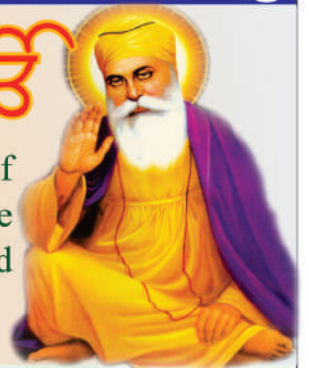

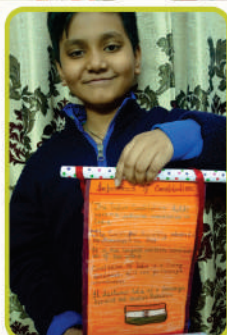
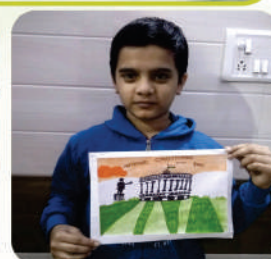
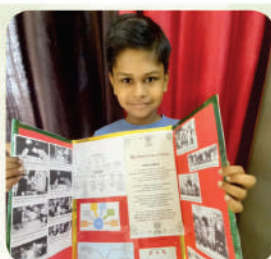
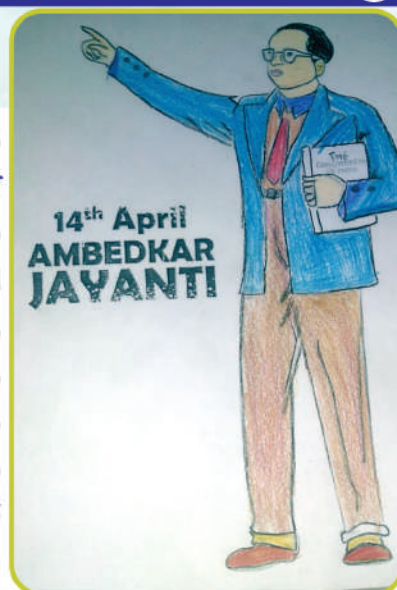
ॐ GURU NANAK JAYANTI CELEBRATION ॐ

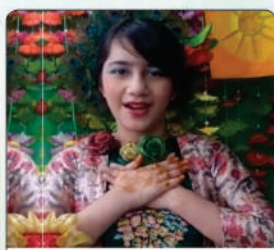
FESTS AND COMPETITIONS
