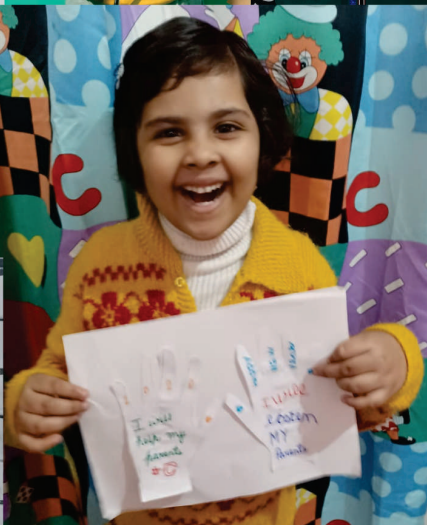
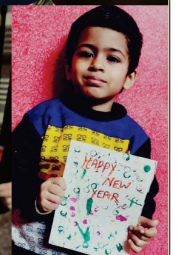
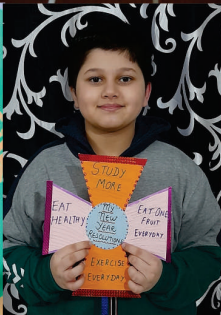
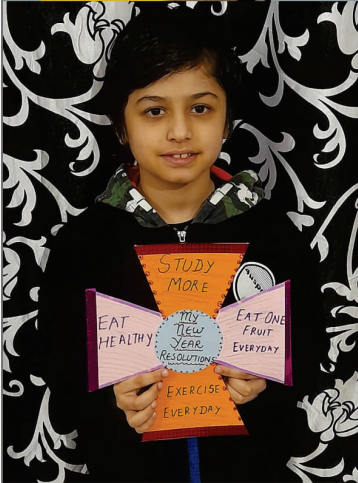
New Year Celebration

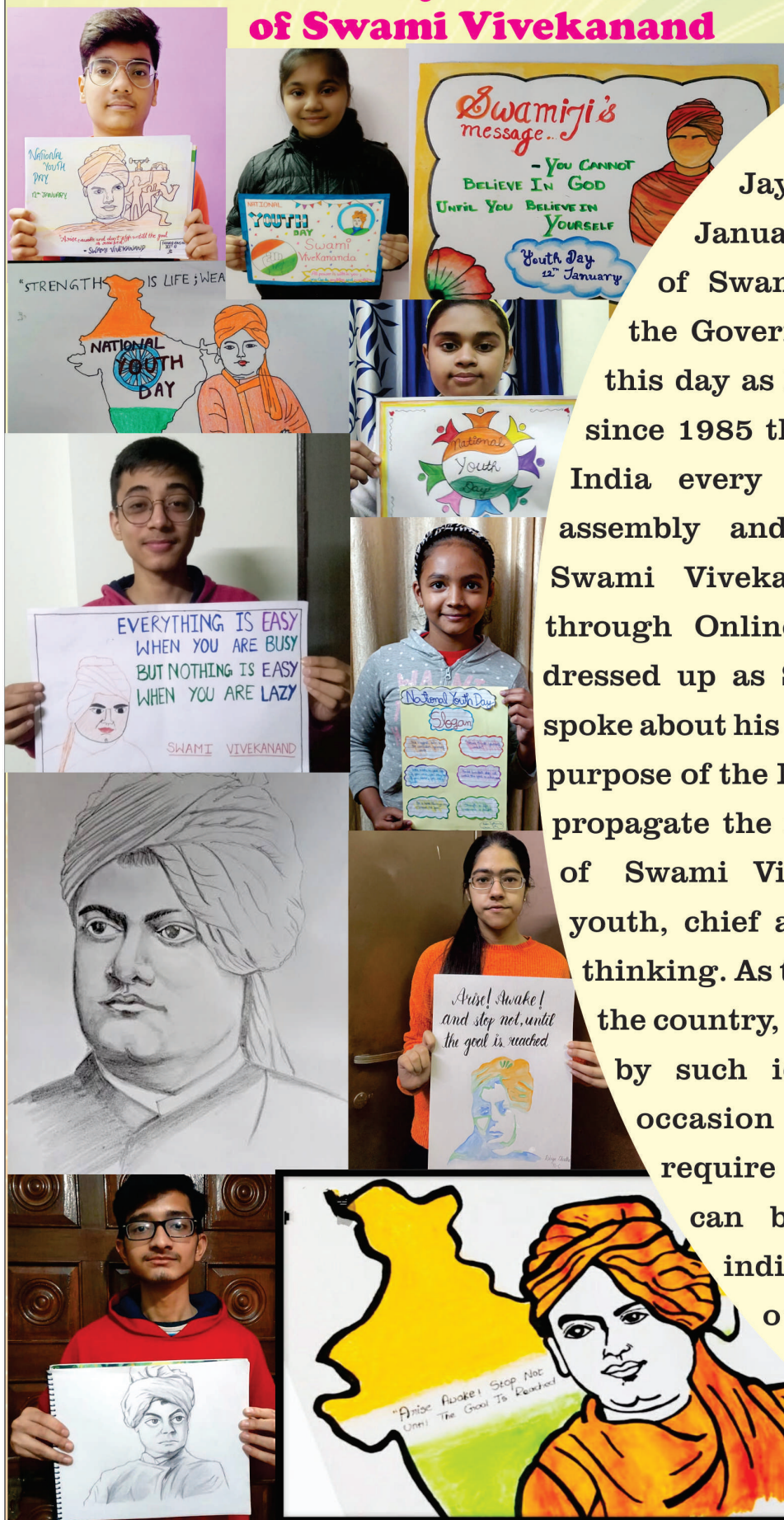
Republic Day Celebration

National Youth Day and Birth Anniversary of Swami Vivekanand

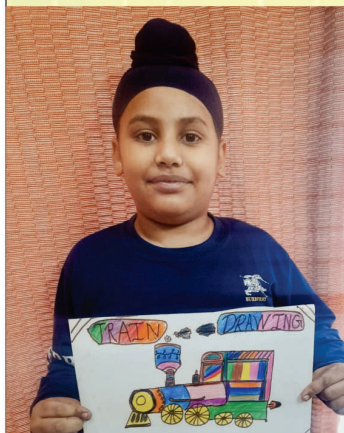

Seminar on Personal Safety Education with children to Prevent Child Abuse

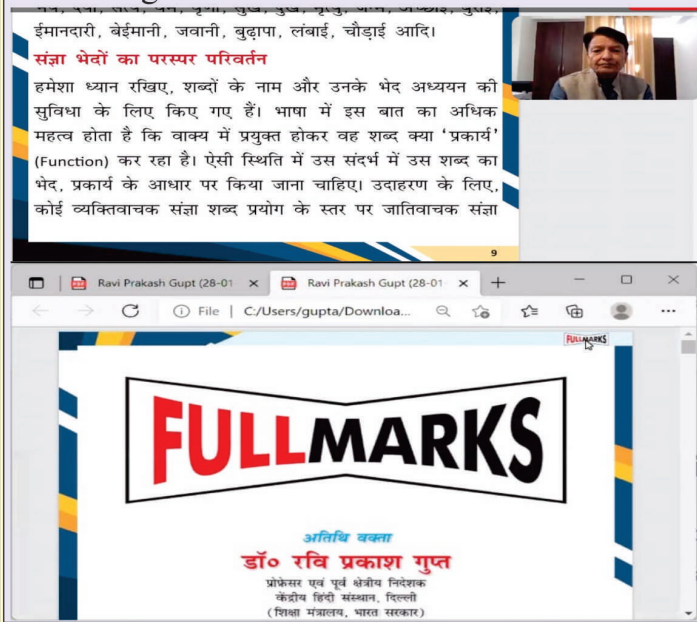
