"Forgive all who have offended you, not for them, but for yourself."

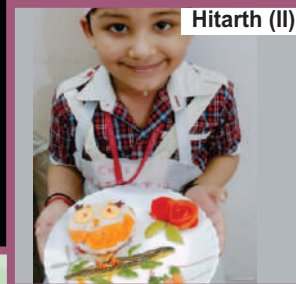
Forgiveness Day

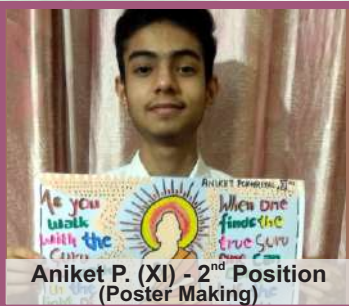

## COVID-19 - A Threat To Mankind

Covid-19 attacks people with low immune system and especially those who are under and over ages. When the response of immune system is low, weak, or damaged, it becomes an open invitation for infections such as coronavirus or other diseases like diabetes, heart disease, or cancer. The following preventive measures can be practiced to fight against all threats of the life....

1. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after being in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
2. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
3. Avoid close contact with the sick people and maintain atleast 6 feet distance, when out in the public.
4. Wear a face covering cloth to cover your mouth and nose properly  
The face cover is meant to protect other people in case you are infected.
5. Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when coughing or sneezing and throw the tissue away after use. If a tissue isn't available, cough or sneeze into your elbow or sleeve, not your hands.
6. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, handles, desks, computers, phones etc.

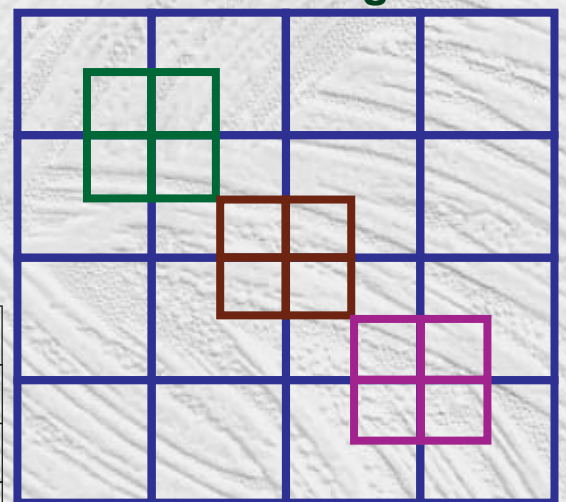
